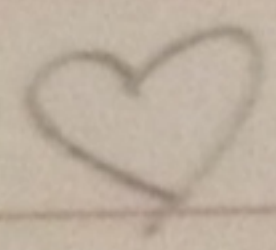





was a beautiful place to

the stillness of the morning





